## **INSPECTOR—GENERAL AUSTRALIAN DEFENCE FORCE— PERFORMANCE MEASUREMENT OF THE MILITARY JUSTICE SYSTEM**

A key role of the Inspector-General Australian Defence Force (IGADF) is to advise the Chief of the Defence Force on the health and effectiveness of the military justice system.

Carrying on from earlier work, IGADF is exploring the efficacy of implementing a targeted survey regime to obtain feedback from key participants in the Australian Defence Force's (ADF) discipline and complaint processes.

Members of the ThinkEvans project team will be contacting identified key stakeholders in the near future seeking their views. Identified stakeholders include Service Headquarters, Defence Personnel Executive, Office of the Chief Military Judge and the Registrar of the Australian Military Court, Office of the Director of Military Prosecutions, ADF Legal Services, Provost Marshal ADF and Fairness and Resolution Branch Directorates.
