- involved in an unacceptable behaviour complaint either as a witness, investigator or the complainant.

Your feedback will assist in improving the military justice system to benefit all Defence personnel.

It is vital to have a system which personnel trust to deliver unbiased, timely and fair outcomes.

The Inspector-General of the Australian Defence Force monitors the military justice system and has commissioned this ongoing feedback questionnaire. The information gathered about your experience will assist in confirming best practice, ensuring that any concerns are addressed. Input will be non-attributable and treated in confidence.
